

## Certificate in Prosthetic FX

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*The College of Media and Artistry Certificate in Prosthetic FX is a course which offers a chance to train in one of the most effective types of makeup artistry.*

*Currently one of the most condensed Prosthetic FX course you can do in Ireland. In this course you will train with the most modern prosthetic methods that are used in filmmaking today and get to produce various casts.*

*You will produce various prosthetics using the following products: silicone, foam latex, and gelatine including a head piece which is part of your final portfolio shoot.*

*Learn how to correctly colour , apply and remove Prosthetic FX.*

*This certificate also includes sculpting and creature design training and all necessary health and safety. Then at the end of your course you will take part in a FX Photo Shoot and receive portfolio images. Each student will design a prosthetic creation using the ongoing training for their photo shoot images , the only limit is your imagination.*

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### What I will learn?

You will be trained in the following units , which an artist needs to succeed in the industry today.

### Mandatory Units:

During the course you will cover :

Face, Ears , limbs casting	Bondo Appliances	Full Head Piece
Face Cast	Foam Gelatine Appliances	Applying Hair
Ear casts	Latex Pieces	Bald Caps
Torso and Hand Casts	Silicone Pieces	Sculpting

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*During the course the students work on their project, a character of original design which will consist of a Face/ headpiece and a minimum of 3 smaller prosthetic pieces with full costume and makeup.*

Some of the topics covered within these units are:

- Special Effects Makeup - Manufacture and fitting of Bald Caps - Colour and Removal of Prosthetics - Application of Foam Latex, Silicone, Gelatine and 3D Transfer Prosthetics - Makeup Portfolio Preparation - Manufacture of Prosthetics - Sculpting - Designing Creatures and Characters- Colour techniques (manual and airbrush) - These topics may change to benefit the students end project and interests.

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#### What will I need?

You will also take part in professional photo shoots throughout the course and receive Portfolio Images from these.

You will need access to a computer, internet and a printer throughout the course.

To complete your VTCT portfolio you will be required to print images and other forms of evidence. You may also have to come in on an extra dates for external/internal verification.

All other equipment and products will be provided for you by the college.

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#### When is it on?

**There are Two Training Options:**

**OPTION ONE:** 3 days a week (Approx. 5 weeks) including Portfolio Photo Shoot : **2nd August 2016**

**COST:** € 2985 includes all certification, all products and equipment provided and Portfolio Images (Deposit €1000)

**OPTION TWO:** 2 days a week (Approx. 9 weeks) including Portfolio Photo Shoot : **7th February 2016**

**COST:** AS ABOVE

\*This course is available to all learners but it is preferable that the learner has a background in art, casting or makeup techniques.
